SAYS COL. MCKEE HAD A “PULL”

Agent Addis, of the Citizens' Municipal Association, yesterday notified Chief Brooks, of the Highway Bureau, that several houses in Hart lane and Boudinot street were not properly underdrained as required by law. The letter in part said: "It is said that all but two of these properties belonged to the late Colonel McKee, a wealthy colored man who died a few days ago. The owners of the adjoining properties were compelled to underdrain all of their houses, but this person seemed to have sufficient influence whereby they were unable to have the nuisance complained of abated."
