RICHEST COLORED WOMAN WEDS

Mrs. A. A. P. Syphax Becomes Bride of Joseph L. Greenwich

Mrs. Abbie A. P. Syphax, the richest colored woman in this city, and, perhaps in the world, married Joseph L. Greenwich, a colored real estate broker of Jersey City yesterday. Mrs. Syphax is the only daughter of the late Colonel John McKee, who died about two years ago. He was worth several million dollars. Mrs. Syphax has been a widow for fifteen years and has five sons.

At the time of Colonel McKee's death he resided at 1040 Lombard st. He was known to be one of the richest men in the city. By his will he left a small portion of his fortune to Mrs. Syphax, but the bulk for the establishment of a Catholic Orphanage. Mrs. Syphax contested the will, but before the case was ended, the executors of the institution compromised.

The wedding took place at the home of Mrs. Lydia Hardy, at 338 E. Smedley st., with whom the bride has been making her home.
