**COL. MCKEE'S DAUGHTER  
HAS RECEIVED \$20,000**

A preliminary accounting in the estate of Colonel John McKee, the negro, who left the bulk of his fortune to Archbishop Ryan and Joseph P. McCullen in trust for the establishment of a training school, ignoring a daughter and other relatives, was filed with the Register of Wills yesterday.

The account shows that there is in the hands of the executors \$71,544.29, of which \$50,534.29 represents the decedent's personal effects.

After the death of the testator a daughter, Mrs. Abbie A. P. Syphax, filed a caveat protesting against the admission of the will to probate, which caveat she subsequently withdrew.

The account filed yesterday shows that she is credited with receiving \$20,000 and Henry McKee Minton, a grandson, \$25,000.
