**RELATIVES FIGHT HARD TO BREAK McKEE'S
WILL**

**The Daughter and Grandsons of Negro Millionaire Prepare to
Oppose Testament.**

Colonel McKee's only surviving daughter, Mrs. Abbie J. Syphax, and his six grandsons are preparing to wage a bitter contest against the execution of the negro millionaire's will.

The document was opened and read yesterday by Charles Irwin, Deputy Register of Wills, and filed to await the preliminary legal steps. It will be necessary for the contestants, who filed a caveat immediately after the testator's death, to enter security in the suit early next week.

T. J. Minton, an attorney, and a son-in-law of Colonel McKee, has made arrangement for complying with this requirement.
