**EXECUTORS DEVELOP
THE MCKEE ESTATE**

**Plans Made to Improve Propert-
ies Left by the Negro**

May 23 **Millionaire.**

Executors of the estate of Colonel John McKee, the negro millionaire, have formed plans for the development of the properties left in their charge.

Within a short time many rows of dwellings will be built on the land in the southern section of the city along Stone House lane. Ten years ago this land was of little value, but the growth of the city has caused a great advance in the worth of the original investment.

The estate's coal and oil lands in West Virginia, Illinois and Kentucky will be developed to their greatest extent.

It is expected the estate will constantly increase in value. The income will be used to erect the John McKee College.
